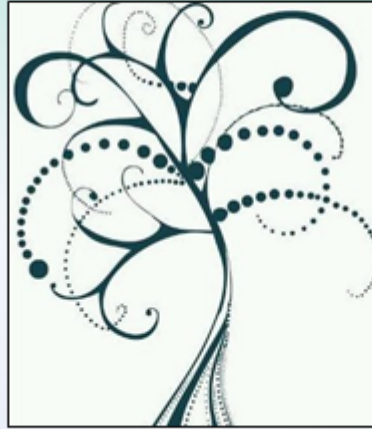


# Tree of Life Fundraising Challenge
